Emergency Department

The **Emergency Department** (located at Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre, 201 Georgian Drive in Barrie) cares for patients whose health problems need immediate attention and cannot wait to be seen by a primary care provider throughout Barrie and surrounding area.

RVH ED Minor Ailment Patient Pathway (MAPP)

Book a **same-day** or **next-day** arrival time to be assessed and treated for minor injuries to a limb (sprain, strain or simple fracture, etc.) or minor symptoms of flu, cold or other respiratory illnesses like RSV and COVID-19. To pre-book your arrival time, visit <u>rvh.on.ca/emergency</u>
